

LCTs in Task Group 124.5, Assault Group O-3, Assault Vessels for Omaha Beach, June 6, 1944.

We have limited information on these LCTs in Assault Group O-3 as they are not listed on the landing diagrams. Any information would be helpful. Again, the names listed after the craft number usually are those of the officers assigned, with the first name that of the OinC, but this may not always be correct.

Task Group 124.6, Assault Group O-4, for Omaha Beach, June 6, 1944.

LCT 413--Chet Roundy--There was only one LCT in Assault O-4 whose primary mission was the assault on Pointe du Hoc. LCT 413's assignment was to launch four dukws which would beach at H-Hour at the same time as the LSTs carrying the 2nd Ranger Battalion. The dukws were loaded with firemen's extension ladders and gear for use by the Rangers to scale the cliff. Note that the Omaha landing diagram indicates LCT 46 in this slot.

LCTs and LCT(A)s landing on Utah beach, Normandy, June 6, 1944.

This information on the individual LCTs was gathered from filed action reports, landing diagrams, memories and the best of other research. Normally the names listed after the hull numbers are those of the officers with the OinC listed first. However, this may not always be the case.
