These LCTs were scheduled to launch DD tanks in time to hit the beach at H-10. Co C, 741th Tank Bn to Fox Green, Co B, 741 Tank Bn to Easy Red.

H-Hour--LCT(A) 2008, 2037, 2043, 2228, 2049, 2287,2339, 2425.

Gunfire Support crafts scheduled to land tanks and tank dozers of Co A, 741st Tank Bn. Tanks had the capability to fire afloat approaching the beach.

Scheduled to land tractors, half tracks, misc. vehicles 5th Det ESB
